SELF-CERTIFICATION

Rule Amendment – CDCC Rule A-9

The Board of Directors of Canadian Derivatives Clearing Corporation (CDCC) has approved the amendment to Rule A-9 and CDCC wishes to advise Clearing Members that the amendment to article A-902 has been self-certified in accordance with the self-certification process as established in the *Derivatives Act* (R.S.Q., chapter I-14.01).

The goal of the modifications is to harmonize the procedures that have been put in place concerning corporate actions on derivative instruments and to harmonize CDCC's Rule with *The Options Clearing Corporation* practices.

This amendment will be in effect and will be incorporated in the version of the Rules which will be available on CDCC's web site (<u>www.cdcc.ca</u>) in the morning of February 12, 2010.
